### Who are we?

The Centre for Sustainability Students is a *student initiative* appointed to be the student extension of the Leiden-Delft-Erasmus Centre for Sustainability ([LDE CFS](#)). Therefore, we hold the same values as this institute. We aim to provide research-based solutions for enhanced resource efficiency taking into consideration the entire product lifecycle based on four shared research areas: Industrial Ecology and Economics, Circular Business Models and Product Design, Clean Technology for Resource Efficiency and Governance, Regulations and Transitions.
