Setup

We offer an interdisciplinary research program on Circular Textiles for graduating master level students. You will work on your own thesis assignment related to Circular Textiles and will take part in an extra-curricular program led by an academic expert in the field. We will organise bi-weekly meetups with experts, external stakeholders and other students. Based on the thesis outcomes we will formulate recommendations for the (Circular) Textiles Industry, which will be shared with external stakeholders in an end-presentation.

- You study at Leiden University, Delft University of Technology or Erasmus University Rotterdam
- You have your own thesis proposal related to Circular Textiles **OR** You are interested in one of the 3 thesis topics from Fashion for Good
- Your educational program fits with the thesis topic of your choice
- You have 1 or 2 academic supervisors from your own university who will guide you in the thesis writing process
- You are committed to take part in the joint extra-curricular program offered by LDE CfS (approximately 2,5 hours a week)
